The implementation of a two-year international project for strengthening the scientific and teaching capacity SCHOLARNET has started

Bulgaria, France and Germany will collaborate to strengthen the research excellence in the area of economic and management research.

The implementation of a two-year international project for strengthening the scientific and teaching capacity within the national scientific program "European Scientific Networks" has started. Leading researchers and scholars from the [Faculty of Economics and Business Administration at the Sofia University St. Kliment Ohridski](#), [Universite de Versailles Saint-Quentin-en-Yvelines](#) and [Friedrich-Alexander-Universität Erlangen-Nürnberg](#) will collaborate. Traditional and innovative academic activities, knowledge transfer and exchange of best practice between research institutions will support the development of sustainable innovation models in public services.

Some of the project activities include international seminars and conferences, a summer school for PhD students, and research focusing on innovations in times of crisis, institutional sustainability, capacity building and reproducibility of successful innovative tools.

The international SCHOLARNET project is in line with the measures set out in the [European Commission 2020 Work Program](#). The project aims to bridge the gap between different level of research capacity among 'innovation leaders' and 'modest innovators' and to strengthen the research convergence.
